Why should you care about this?

- These projects will cost billions, money that could be spent on renewable energy.
- The pipelines linking the terminals to California will endanger communities, cross hundreds of peoples' property, and will tear apart public lands.
- LNG is not needed in Oregon; even the Governor admits that most of the gas is going out of state.
- Ask yourself: Why is Oregon being chosen for LNG that will go to California?
